In the event of an accident or illness, you may be limited in your ability to act and make decisions. You can make provisions for these situations with a Power of Attorney. The Power of Attorney regulates who legally represents you if you can no longer make your own decisions. If no trusted third party can be authorized, you have the option of issuing a care directive. If there is no Power of Attorney or care directive, the Betreuungsgericht (Court of Protection) can appoint a legal guardian.

The Guardianship Authority is the point of contact for information and advice on legal precautionary options. It issues notarized signatures for powers of attorney. The Guardianship Authority arranges guardianship-avoiding assistance on a case-by-case basis.

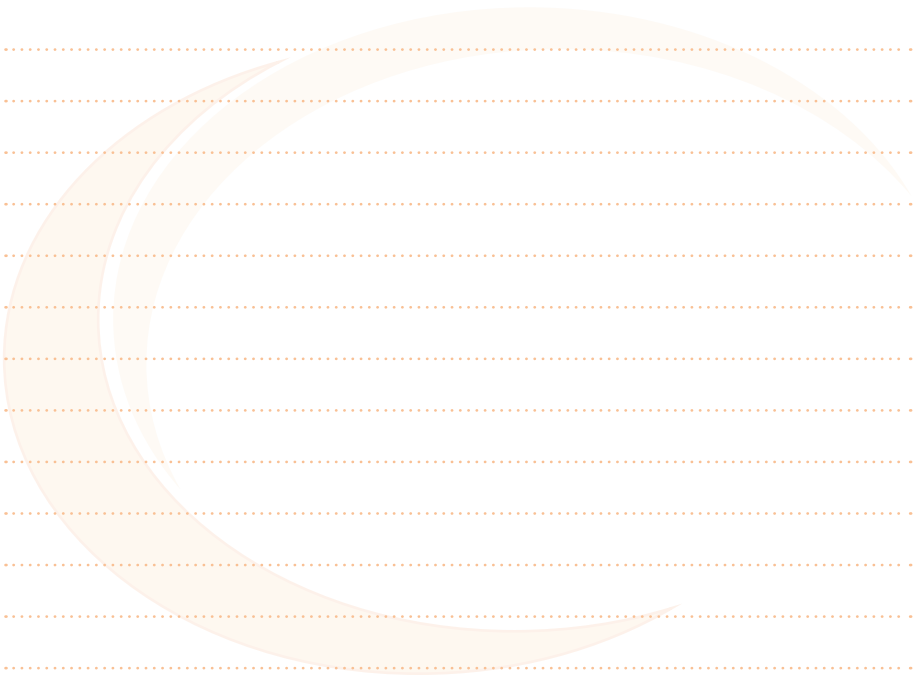

## Treatment

In the Böblingen district, there are various treatment and therapy offerings.



To better understand the different treatment options available, it is important to distinguish between two main forms of care:

**Outpatient treatment** means that you attend regular appointments for therapy, counselling, or medical treatment while continuing to live in your usual environment. Services such as the Psychiatric Outpatient Clinics (PIA) and Day Clinics provide intensive treatment during the day without the need for an inpatient stay. After treatment, you return home.

If outpatient treatment is not sufficient and more comprehensive care and support are required around the clock, this is referred to as **inpatient treatment**. For residents of the Böblingen district, **Klinikum Nordschwarzwald (ZfP Calw) is the responsible specialist psychiatric hospital**. In addition to general psychiatric care, it also offers specialised services, such as a Clinic for Geriatric Psychiatry and Psychotherapy, which focuses on the needs of older people in a protected setting.

There are also important local options for inpatient treatment **within the Böblingen district**. These include the Clinic for Psychosomatic Medicine and Psychotherapy at Leonberg Hospital and the **Psychiatric Treatment Centre (PBZ) at Böblingen Hospital**. These facilities provide specialised inpatient treatment, for example in the field of psychosomatic medicine or for specific psychiatric conditions. They therefore complement the broader psychiatric services offered by Klinikum Nordschwarzwald.

To help you find your way around this guide, the services listed in the following chapter, “Treatment”, are marked as either  **inpatient** or  **outpatient** services.

Finding the right support is not always easy, especially during a mental health crisis. This is where counselling services can help. They provide guidance, help you understand which type of support may be most suitable for your situation, and assist you with the next steps.

A detailed overview of counselling services, including the Social Psychiatric Service (p. 10), the IBB Office, the Contact, Advice and Mediation Centre (ABV), and the District Social Service, can be found in the chapter “Advice and Assistance” (from page 8).

## 2 Treatment



### Clinics

The Psychiatric Treatment Centre (PBZ) Böblingen is a local inpatient service of Klinikum Nordschwarzwald and is located at Böblingen Hospital. It comprises two wards with 27 beds each. For the support and treatment of people in crisis situations, an intensive care unit with four beds is available. Patients are generally accommodated in twin rooms.

### Psychiatric outpatient clinics (PIA)

Psychiatric outpatient clinics treat patients who are dependent on treatment by the institute's outpatient clinic due to the type, severity, or duration of their mental illness or because they are too far away from suitable contract doctors. PIAs also regularly avoid inpatient admissions and shorten inpatient treatment. Emergency patients are admitted immediately.

There are five outpatient clinics in the Böblingen district. The main location of the PIA is at the Calw Psychiatric Center. From there, the district is served by external consultation hours at the community psychiatric centers (GPZ) in Leonberg, Sindelfingen, and Herrenberg, as well as at the day clinic in Böblingen.

The Rudolf-Sophien-Stift in Stuttgart also offers PIAs, as does the Adult Psychiatric Outpatient Clinic (PIA) St. Damiano of the Liebenau Foundation in Stuttgart-Bad-Cannstatt. This PIA is aimed at people with intellectual and multiple disabilities.

## Vocational Training Area

Qualification in the Vocational Training Area (BBB) of the Workshop for Disabled People (WfbM) usually lasts two years and includes a wide range of services for participation in working life. In addition to practical work activities, theoretical content and cultural techniques are also taught. Internships in the work area of the WfbM, with other service providers, with inclusive companies, or with companies in the general labor market are also possible.

Usually, a recognized vocational qualification cannot be obtained in the vocational training area. At the end of qualification in the Vocational Training Area, a decision is made as to whether subsequent employment with another service provider or with a WfbM is the most suitable form of participation in working life. (A move to the general labor market is also possible at a later date):
