

Value transmission

Between July 2016 and February 2017, the Office for Migration and Refugees provided a concept for value transmission for refugees. In the shared accommodation facilities, units designed specifically for the target audience were delivered in small groups, supported by the social care workers on site. Using the expertise of cooperation partners from the Stuttgart Region and Böblingen, low-threshold training opportunities were conceived and carried out. The topics “Diversity in German society”, “Understanding the roles of men and women”, “Preventing radicalisation” and “Children and education” were covered. Now the Department for Integration has published a handout which collates the methodological content and describes the approaches to implementation. The aim is that this will serve as a guideline, enabling instructors to realise a value transmission.
